





SUBJECT:

Permanent Resident Sponsor Responsibility and Reimbursement

PURPOSE:

Outline financial responsibility of permanent resident sponsors and to provide for reimbursement of Indigent Healthcare Program benefits by permanent resident sponsors.

POLICY:

 Permanent resident sponsors are financially responsible for the medical needs of the individual who is applying for the Indigent Healthcare Program, according to the I-864 Affidavit of Support signed on behalf of the sponsored permanent resident. The Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program qualifies as a "means-tested public benefit" within the meaning of Section 213A of the Immigration and Nationality Act. See the excerpt below from Section 213A of the Immigration and Nationality Act (statute codified at 8 USC 1183a and regulations at 8 CFR 213a).

> Immigrants admitted to the United States must demonstrate that he or she will not become a "public charge", that is, a recipient of welfare programs. One way the immigrant can show financial responsibility is to have a sponsor sign an affidavit of support. The sponsor is usually a family member, a US citizen, or lawful resident, age 18 or over, and live within the United States or its territories or possessions. The sponsor usually must demonstrate the ability to maintain an income of at least 125% of the federal poverty level for the household size. If a sponsored immigrant receives "means-tested public benefits", the sponsor must repay the amount of benefits upon request by the agency that provides the benefits.

2. According to Section 61.008 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, the Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program will include the income and resources of a person (and the sponsor's spouse, if applicable) who executed an affidavit of support on behalf of a sponsored alien when determining the applicant's eligibility. A "sponsored alien" means a person who has been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence under the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.) and who, as a condition of admission, was sponsored by a person who executed an affidavit of support on behalf of the person.

3. Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program considers Indigent Healthcare Program benefits to be a means-tested public benefit and will request reimbursement from the permanent resident sponsor.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program requires a copy of the originally filed and signed Form I-864, Affidavit of Support.
- 2. According to Form I-864, a sponsor is financially responsible for persons that they sponsor.
- 3. The sponsor's financial responsibility will only be waived under circumstances in the Form I-864.
- 4. A copy of the I-864 can be obtained by filing Form G-639, Freedom of Information Act Request, with the USCIS. The G-639 must be filed to request the I-864 and is available at <u>www.uscis.gov</u>.
- 5. A demand letter and a bill will be sent to the sponsor giving the sponsor forty-five (45) days to pay the bill in full.
- 6. Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program will use every available legal remedy to pursue reimbursement from the sponsor. This may include filing a lawsuit against the sponsor for the amount of money expended on benefits by Kaufman County Indigent Healthcare Program for the sponsored immigrant.

- 2. The Commissioners Court of Kaufman County will appoint a Road Superintendent per Texas Transportation Code Chapter 252, Subchapter C, "Road Superintendent System", effective October 1, 2019;
- 3. Each County Commissioner may retain a small cadre of equipment and workforce for the purpose of responding to small, urgent local road and bridge needs;
- 4. During the first two years of the Road Superintendent's appointment, changes in personnel proposed by the Road Superintendent must be approved by the Commissioners Court;
- 5. During the first two years of the Road Superintendent's appointment, existing maintenance facilities will remain in place and in use unless a change is approved by the Commissioners Court; and
- 6. On a regular basis, the Road Superintendent will provide the Commissioners Court a detailed list of proposed project priorities with estimated costs. These priorities will be subject to approval by the Commissioners Court.
