**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY MEETING
KAUFMAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT**

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to 551.045 of the Texas Government Code, an emergency meeting of the Kaufman County Commissioners' Court will be held on **Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 8:30 a.m., in the Commissioners Court Meeting Room located in the Courthouse Annex 100 W. Mulberry Street, Kaufman, Texas** at which time the commissioners' court will consider the following items for discussion, and possible action, to wit:

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the imminent threat it poses to the public health and safety of Kaufman County and its citizens, the Kaufman County Commissioners Court finds that this emergency meeting is necessary.

1. **Call to Order.**
2. Discuss/Consider extending Kaufman County's Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency issued by Judge Richards on March 18, 2020.
3. Discuss issuing a Shelter in Place Order under the authority of Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.
4. Discuss/Consider extending the Order for Shelter in Place.
5. **Adjourn Emergency Meeting.**

If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the Commissioners' Court will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act and the Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapter D and E; as noted below

Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the Commissioners' Court with regards to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

(a) in the open meeting covered by the notice upon the reconvening of the public meetings; or
(b) at a subsequent open public meeting of the Commissioners' Court upon notice thereof; as the Commissioners' Court shall determine.

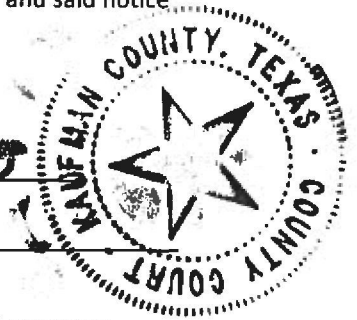
