KAUFMAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT**

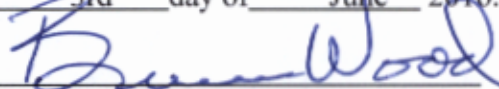
